TASTING NOTES

Our 2019 Chardonnay has mouthwatering aromatics of spice rubbed pineapple, dried lemon, and butter brushed apple tart. A bright entry evolves into rich midpalate richness of white nectarines and homemade gram crackers. This wine's natural acidity carries these flavors, only begging for another taste.

THE VINEYARDS

The Chardonnay is sourced from two vineyards in Sonoma County - Simpatico in Bennett Valley and Smith in Dry Creek Valley. Both vineyards are located in unusually cool pockets of Sonoma and their unique microclimates make them very well suited to produce the type of Chardonnay we love - opulent yet elegant, somewhat steely, with bright fresh fruit and crisp acidity.
