## TASTING NOTES

C'est Si Bon in French means "It's so good!" Say no more! A bright, fresh nose of ripe raspberry, rose petals, and cherry pie. Grenache flavors lead the palate with rich strawberry, cranberry, and a hint of cinnamon. Subtle soft tannins allow this verastile wine to be served with a slight chill and enjoyed in the summer months.

## THE VINEYARDS

A combination of unique vineyard sites, each parcel adds to the layers of this wine and its polished, approachable character. Spanning four appellations of Northern California, this wine is proof that sometimes the sum is greater than its parts.
